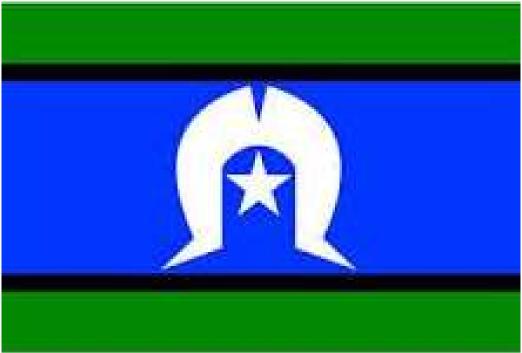

We have lots of sensitive ears.


Some of us can be overwhelmed by sudden noises, loud noises, and crunchy scratchy noises.

The planet should be your 'utopia', the place where you would live if you could.


It's an opportunity to tap into your imagination and what's important to you.


We will use our workbooks, or the A3 sheets of paper, to 'design' the planets in 2D. You might like to:

- You don't need to consider all of the questions when you are 'designing' just the ones that interest you!
- Remember you are designing your ideal planet the type of place you would love to live or visit. Maybe in ways that includes things from earth.





- Do they Live in towns and cities?






